

Tornado Shelters

Tornado Shelters are in. For the past few years the events committee has been raising funds for storm shelters at the lake. 2019 & 2020 (flood & Covid) derailed the plans slightly, but in 2021 we were able to get back on track. We were able to reach our goal and in early May two tornado shelters were installed. One is located near the horseshoe pit on the NW side of the lake and the second is located near the Terry Held Building on the east side of the lake. The shelters got their first action less than a week after being installed on May 12th strong storms moved through the area with winds in the area up to 110 mph.


Trail of Lights



Camping Reservations







Minimum stay of 2 nights for electrical reservations - \$30 per night

(Maximum stay of 14 days)

There are 30-amp campsites for \$30 per night and 50-amp campsites that are also \$30 per night (50-amp sites: Campsites #2, #6, #7 and #8 at the Dam Campground and Campsites G, H and J at the River Campground)

All camp sites are back in ONLY....there are no drive through sites.

Tent camping is also available at two locations. No reservations required - first come first serve. Cost is \$10 per night per tent. (no minimum stay)

Camping Payments

Payment must be received within five (5) days, if paying by a check or immediately if paying by a credit card, after camping reservation is made to guarantee your site. If payment is not paid within this time, you will lose your spot.
